JUDGMENT

The Accused/Defendant stand trial for an offence contrary to and punishable under Section 1(2) (c) of the Miscellaneous Offences Act CAP M17, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria 2004, in that he on or about 25th October, 2017 at Plot 10, Alakija Road, Satellite Town, Amufo Odofin, Lagos State, within the jurisdiction of the Honourable Court did commit a felony to wit, forging of Eko Electricity Distribution Bills.

On the 11th January, 2018 when the charge was read over to the Accused/Defendant he understood same and pleaded guilty.

I have considered the submission of the Prosecution and I am of the view that the Prosecution has proof the case beyond reasonable doubt and I hereby convict the

Accused/Defendant accordingly as charge.

Question: Do you understand the conviction?

Question: Mitigating plea (Allucutus).

Convict: I pray to the Court to tender mercy to me. It will never happen

again.

Court; Any previous conviction?

Prosecution: Not any to my knowledge.

But however the Convict cannot go unpunished so as to serve as deterrent to him and to other citizen in the society who are found of committing same offence.

I hereby sentence you Eyo Okon to two (2) months prison term from the date of first arres.
