**JUDGMENT**

The Defendant herein was first arraigned on an Information dated 2/04/19 on which he pleaded Not Guilty on 8/05/19 although his Counsel informed the Court the defence had already forwarded a proposed Plea Bargain Agreement to the Prosecution. Consequent upon the acceptance of same by the Prosecution, an Amended Information dated 21/05/2019 was filed and the Defendant pleaded guilty to same today sequel to the afore stated Plea Bargain Agreement. The Prosecution tendered documents and the laptop recovered from the Defendant which are **Exhibits P1-P6** before the Court. The Prosecution in its Review of facts of same date stated that following series of Intelligence Report availed to the Commission from different persons/corporate bodies on notorious activities of individuals known as "Yahoo Boys" in different locations and hideouts, a surveillance was mounted leading to the arrest of the Defendant and others already standing trials in different Courts.

The Defendant having pleaded to the 1 Count Information is hereby convicted as charged. The proposed Term of Imprisonment is one year upon conviction. The Defendant is therefore hereby sentenced to one year imprisonment from today.

However due to the early agreement to Plea Bargain the Defendant is hereby granted an option of a fine of ₦250,000:00 in lieu of his prison sentence. The Defendant shall also forfeit his laptop being **Exhibit P. 6** to the Federal Government of Nigeria.

The Defendant shall also upon his release from custody undertake to the Commission to be of good behaviour and never to be involved in any form of crime again.

This is the Judgment of the Court.
