**JUDGMENT**


The Defendant has been re-arraigned on a one Count Information dated 27/06/19 on possession of fraudulent Documents contrary to **Section 320** of the **Criminal Law of Lagos State, 2015** to which he pleaded Guilty on the strength of a Plea Bargain Agreement dated 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2019. The Prosecution tendered the Defendant's Confessional Statements and the documents printed out from his e-mail which are Exhibits P1-P5 before the Court.

The Defendant having pleaded Guilty and having executed the Plea Bargain Agreement with his lawyer and the Prosecution is hereby convicted as charged.

A term of 1 year imprisonment has been proposed in the Plea Bargain Agreement and the Defendant is accordingly sentenced to one year imprisonment with commencement from 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2019 being the date of his arrest and detention by the EFCC. All the items recovered from the Defendant; i.e.


- 1) 1 silver coloured HP Laptop Elite book Folio 9470 being the proceed of unlawful activities.
- 2) One Black coloured Compaq Laptop with serial No 2CFE 9190B2P proceed of unlawful activities.
- 3) One Gold coloured Gionee Phone, shall be forfeited to the Federal Government of Nigeria

The Defendant shall upon his release from custody enter into a Bond with EFCC to be of good behaviour and never to be involved in any crime within or outside the shores of Nigeria.



However in view of the prompt agreement to a Plea Bargain, the Defendant is hereby granted an option of fine in the sum of N250,000:00 in lieu of his prison sentence.
