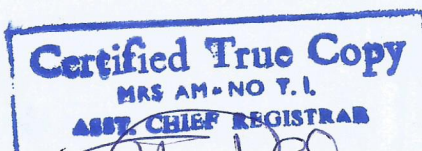

The charge is read and explained to the defendant in English language to the satisfaction of the court.

The defendant has pleaded guilty to the charge.

Review of the facts:

PW1 confirms to tell the truth and states in English language as follows:

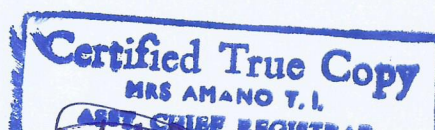
My name is Sameer Soye, I work with EFCC. I know the defendant. Sometime on the 3rd of July 2019 defendant was arrested at 23rd Avenue, Trans-Ekulu, Enugu. And brought to our office where I read the incident report to him, and he understood it.

And upon further investigation, his email address was accessed using his I-phone in his pressure where a document printed where he presented himself as one Michael Gracias and a black American contractor working at Ohio clevel and U.S.A where he obtained by trick the sum of \$100=from one Janice an American citizen subsequently cautioning words were administered on him and he volunteered his statement.

These are the statements made by the defendant and the documents referred to in my evidence.

They are tendered in evidence in Exhibits A,B,C,D,E,F,G,H,J and K respectively.

The prosecuting counsel has referred the plea bargain agreement entered into with the defendant dated 19/7/2019.



Court: Upon the plea of guilty by the defendant and upon the review of the facts of the case the defendant is found guilty as charged.

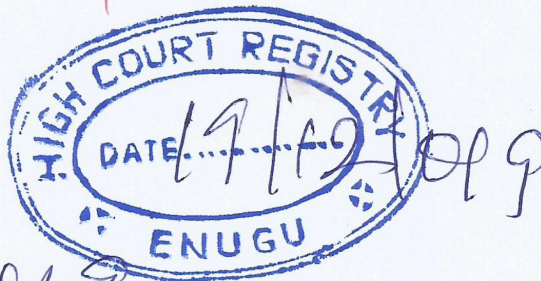
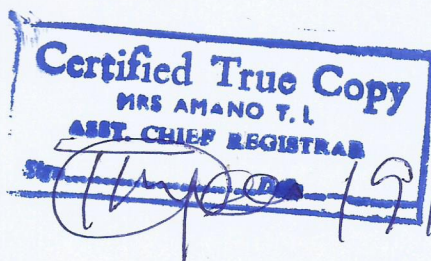
The defence counsel has pleaded with the court to temper justice with mercy. That he is a Youth corper.

Court: Pursuant to the plea bargain agreement entered into between the prosecuting and the defendant, the defendant is sentenced to one month imprisonment with hard labour.

2. The defendant shall forfeit to the Federal Republic of Nigeria the sum of one hundred dollars being the money fraudulently obtained from the victim, Janice Pholan.
