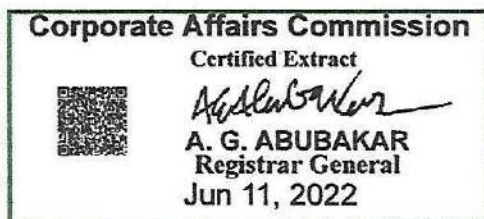

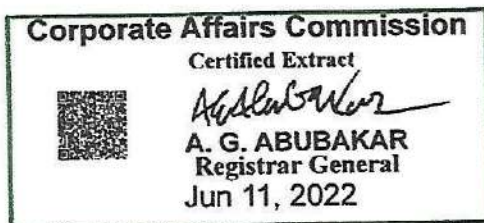

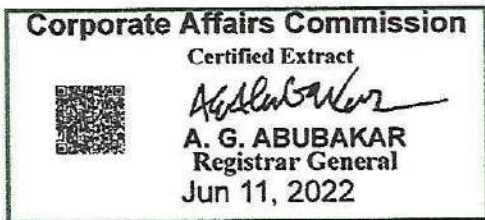

PREAMBLE

We, the members of VISION HELP & GRASSROOT SUPPORT INITIATIVE a not for-profit and non-political organisation do firmly and solemnly resolve to provide for ourselves a constitution and to be governed by the provisions therein contained.

ARTICLE 1: NAME

The name of the Association is VISION HELP & GRASSROOT SUPPORT INITIATIVE

ARTICLE 2: ADDRESS

The address of the Association shall be : 66, IBB WAY, CALABAR, NIGERIA

ARTICLE 3: AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

SN	THE AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE ASSOCIATION ARE:
1	TO ALLEVIATE POVERTY BY BUILDING THE CAPACITY OF PERSONS IN GRASSROOTS AREAS THROUGH HUMAN CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT.
2	TO CREATE OPPORTUNITIES TO IMPROVE THE WELFARE OF VULNERABLE MEMBERS OF THE SOCIETY.
3	TO SUPPORT GRASSROOTS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT THROUGH BUSINESS SUPPORT PROGRAMMES.

ARTICLE 4: TRUSTEES



- A. The Trustees of VISION HELP & GRASSROOT SUPPORT INITIATIVE for the purpose of the Companies and Allied Matters Act CAP C20 LFN 2004, shall be elected at a General Meeting charged with responsibility of selecting the Trustees with 2/3 majority votes of members present.
- B. Such Trustees (Hereinafter referred to as, "The Trustees") shall not be less than 2 and more than 15 in number.
- C. A Trustee may hold office for 5 years but shall cease to hold office if he:
 - 1. Resigns his office
 - 2. Ceases to be a member of the registered Trustees of the body.
 - 3. Becomes insane
 - 4. Is officially declared bankrupt
 - 5. Is convicted of a criminal offence involving dishonesty by a Court of competent jurisdiction
 - 6. Is recommended for removal from office by a board of Governors and Trustees majority vote of members present at any General Meeting of the body
 - 7. Ceases to reside in Nigeria
- D. Upon a vacancy occurring in the number of Trustees a General Meeting will be held to appoint another eligible member of the Association.

ARTICLE 5: COMMON SEAL

- A. The Trustees shall have a Common seal.
- B. Such seal will be kept in the custody of the SECRETARY who shall produce it when required for use by the Trustees.
- C. All documents to be executed by the Trustees shall be signed by such number of them and sealed with the Common seal.

ARTICLE 6: MEETINGS

For effective administration of the Association, there shall be the following meetings

1	ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.	At least two third (2/3) or ten (depending on which is less) of the registered members of the Association as present inclusive of three (3) members of the executive.
2	EMERGENCY MEETINGS.	At least two third (2/3) or five (depending on which is less) of the registered members of the Association present.
3	BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING.	A minimum of 2 members shall form a quorum and the Board shall appoint other officers and regulate its own procedure at the meetings.

ARTICLE 8: SOURCES OF INCOME

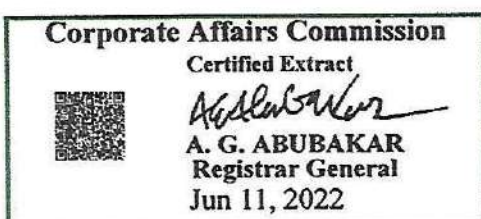
The sources of income for the Association shall include:

1. (A.) REGISTRATION FEES (NEW MEMBERS ONLY)
2. (B.) ANNUAL LEVIES
3. (C.) FUNDRAISERS/LAUNCHINGS
4. (D.) FINES
5. (E.) LEVIES
6. (F.) DONATIONS, GIFTS OR GRANTS FOR SPECIFIC OR GENERAL PROJECTS/PURPOSES.

ARTICLE 9: DISBURSEMENT AND APPLICATION OF FUNDS

(I) THE ASSOCIATION SHALL AT THE INCEPTION OF EACH YEAR HAVE AND OPERATE AN ANNUAL BUDGET WHICH SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AND RATIFIED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES. (II) DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS AND GIFTS SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND SHALL SOLELY BE TOWARDS THE PROMOTION OF THE OBJECTS OF THE ASSOCIATIONS. (III) AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE ASSOCIATION, THE INTERNAL AUDITOR SHALL PRESENT AN ANNUAL AUDIT/FINANCIAL REPORT TO THE ENTIRE ASSOCIATION. (IV) THE FINANCIAL YEAR OF THE ASSOCIATION SHALL RUN FROM 1ST JANUARY TO 31ST DECEMBER OF EACH YEAR.

ARTICLE 10: KEEPING ACCOUNT



I. THE ASSOCIATION SHALL OPEN AND OPERATE SAVINGS AND CURRENT ACCOUNTS WITH LEADING COMMERCIAL BANKS AS APPROVED BY THE TRUSTEES. II. ALL MONIES REALIZED AS REVENUE BY THE ASSOCIATION SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE ASSOCIATION'S BANK ACCOUNT WITHIN SEVENTY-TWO (72) HOURS. ANY OTHER CASH PAYMENTS SHALL BE MADE THROUGH THE TREASURER. III. THE CHAIRMAN, SECRETARY AND THE TREASURER SHALL BE SIGNATORIES TO THE ACCOUNTS OF THE ASSOCIATION. IV. REVENUE/FUNDS ACCRUING TO THE ASSOCIATION FROM OVERSEAS MEMBERS AND FRIENDS SHALL BE RECEIVED AND LODGED IN THE ASSOCIATION'S BANK ACCOUNT IN SUCH A MANNER AS MAY BE DIRECTED BY THE TRUSTEES. V. THE CHAIRMAN SHALL HAVE DISCRETIONARY POWERS TO APPROVE INCOMES AND EXPENDITURES NOT EXCEEDING N100, 000.00. VI. ANY AMOUNT IN EXCESS OF N100, 000.00 MUST BE APPROVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL. VII. THE CLOSING BALANCE (CREDIT/DEBIT) AS CONTAINED IN THE RECEIPT AND PAYMENT ACCOUNT AS AT THE END OF THE PRECEDING MEETING OF THE ASSOCIATION SHALL BE READ OUT BY THE TREASURER AT EVERY GENERAL MEETING. VIII. THE ASSOCIATION'S BANK BOOKS SHALL BE PRESENTED TO THE GENERAL MEETING AT EVERY SITTING. IX. THE ASSOCIATION SHALL USE ITS FUNDS TO EMBARK ON ANY PROJECT BENEFICIAL TO ANY PART OF THE COMMUNITY.

ARTICLE 11: APPOINTMENT OF AUDITOR(S)

1. Independent qualified and licenced Auditors shall be appointed by the general meeting to audit the financial records of the Association annually and submit an audited report to the Annual General Meeting of the Association.
2. The audited financial statements (balance sheet and income and expenditure account) duly certified by independent auditors shall be annexed to the annual returns and file with the Corporate Affairs Commission.

ARTICLE 12: AMENDMENT OF CONSTITUTION

The Association may alter the provision of its Constitution at a General meeting by a resolution passed by a simple majority of its members and approved by the Commission.

ARTICLE 13: SPECIAL CLAUSE

1. THE INCOME AND PROPERTY OF VISION HELP & GRASSROOT SUPPORT INITIATIVE shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objective of the body as set forth in this RULES AND REGULATION/CONSTITUTION: and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise howsoever by way of profit, to the members of the Association.
2. PROVIDED that nothing herein shall prevent the payment in good faith, or reasonable and proper remuneration to any officer or servant of the Association in return for any service actually rendered to the Association:
 - a. With the exception of ex-officio members of the Governing Council, no member of the Council of Management or Governing Body shall be appointed to any salaried office of the Association or any

office of the Association paid by fees; and

- b. No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the body to any member of such Council or Governing Body except repayment of out of pocket expenses or reasonable and proper rent for premises demised, or let to the Association or reasonable fees for services rendered.
- 3. If in the event of a liquidation/winding-up or dissolution of the corporate body there remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Association but shall be given or transferred to some other institutions, having objectssimilar to the object of Association, such institutions to be determined by the members of the Association at or before the time of dissolution.
- 4. If effect cannot be given to the aforesaid provisions, then the remaining property shall be transferred to some charitable object.
