ORDER



AN ORDER of this Honourable Court admitting the 1st – 3rd Defendants/Applicants to bail.

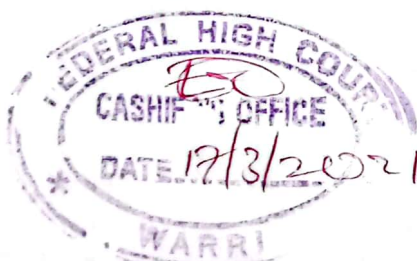
AND for such further order or orders as this Honourable Court may deem fit to make in this circumstances.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Bail is granted to each of the Defendants/Applicants in the sum of N10,000,000.00 (Ten Million Naira) and two sureties each in the like sum whom shall depose to an affidavit of means.
2. That the first surety shall be a landed property owner with a Certificate of Occupancy or Registered Deed within jurisdiction and the documents must be verified by the Registrar of this court and also deposit same with the Station Registrar of this court.
3. That the second surety shall be a Civil Servant of not less than grade level 14 in the service and his/her Original letter of appointment and/ or Promotion letter shall be verified by the Registrar of the Court and shall be deposited with the Station Registrar of the Court.
4. That the surety shall produce evidence of payment of 3 years recent tax clearance certificate which must be verified by the Court.
5. That both counsel shall supervise and interview the proposed sureties before the applicant is formally released on bail and this must be done within 48 hours.
6. That the Applicant together with the sureties shall each deposit two copies of their recent passport photographs with the Station Registrar.
7. That the permanent residence of the sureties shall be verified and confirmed by the Registrar of this court/ police officer.

That this case is adjourned to 10/3/2021 for trial.
