JUDGMENT

The Defendant is charged in a one count charge punishable by Section 17(b) of the EFCC Act. He pleaded Guilty to the Charge.


The Court is informed that the Defendant applied for a plea deal and this resulted in a Plea Bargain Agreement which he signed together with his Counsel and Counsel to the Commission.

I have taken into consideration the fact that he has pleaded Guilty and saved the Court the time it would have spent trying this case.

I have also examined and considered the Plea Bargain Agreement and I find it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Defendant is sentenced to 5 years in a Correction Centre or pay a fine of N500,000.00.

The Defendant will enter an undertaking in writing to be of good conduct and desist from further criminal acts.
