
## JUDGMENT

In view of the Plea of the defendant and unchallenged evidence of PW1 with documentary evidence tendered, the defendant is hereby convicted as charged.

ALLOCUTUS: The defendant counsel pleads with the Court to tamper justice with mercy.

Consequently:-
