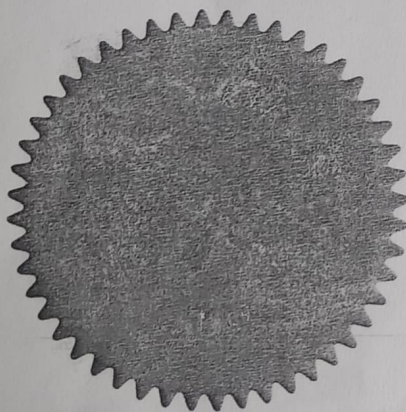
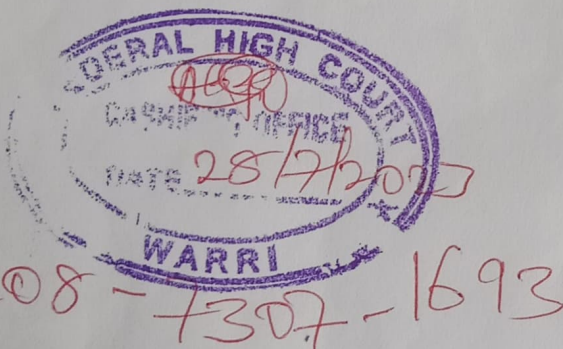
JUDGMENT ORDER

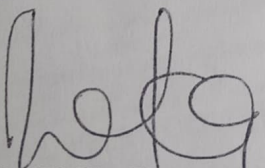

3. *The* sentences shall run concurrently.
4. *The* convict is to forfeit to the Federal Government of Nigeria, all the items recovered in the Bridal Shop and three phones which are proceeds of crime and the properties be sold and proceeds remitted to the victims of the crime through the Economic & Financial Crimes Commission (E.F.C.C.).
5. *An Order* is hereby made that E.F.C.C. should refroze the Account of the convict with the Access Bank, Mission Road, Benin City.
6. *The* convict shall undertake in writing to be of good behavior and Law abiding.
