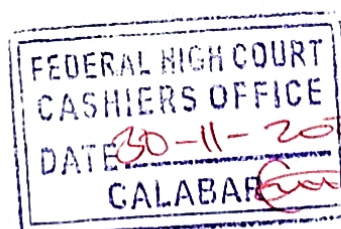
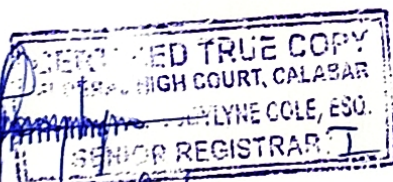
THE CHARGE HAVING been read to the Defendant in English Language and he pleaded guilty thereto.

AND THE COURT having delivered its Judgment.



IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

3. That the Convict shall be remanded in the Medium Correctional Centre, Calabar pending the fulfillment of the fine.

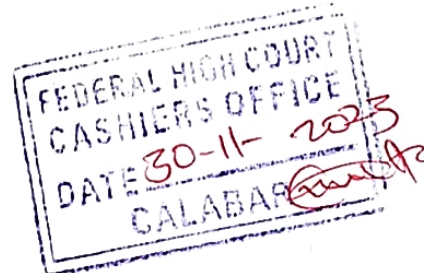
