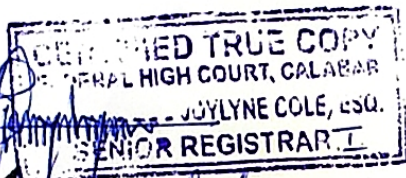

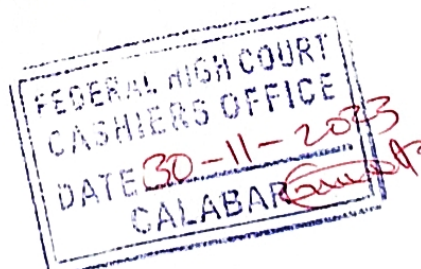

THE CHARGE was read to the Defendant in English Language and he pleaded guilty thereto.






1. That the Convict is sentenced to Twelve (12) Months imprisonment with an option of fine of ₦ 700, 000.00 (Seven Hundred Thousand Naira) only.
