
SENTENCE ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

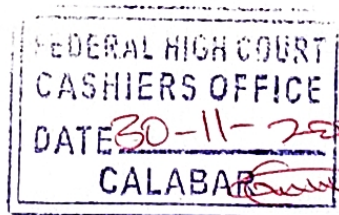


