JUDGMENT

The Defendant is charged in one count with false representation contrary to Section 384(1) of Criminal Code Law Edo State. He pleaded guilty to the charge.

The Court is informed that he entered a Plea Bargain Agreement with the commission of his own volition.

I have heard the facts as presented by the prosecution. I have also heard the plea of Learned Counsel for mercy.

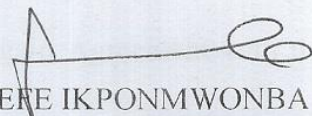
In sentencing the Defendant, I have taken into consideration the fact that by pleading guilty he has saved the time of the Court. I have also considered the fact that the Defendant is a very young man and from an indigent home. I have decided to exercise my discretion and vary the agreed terms. Considering the

facts revealed, I believe it would not be in the interest of the Defendant to sentence him to a Correctional Centre as he is at an impressionable age.

Consequently, the Defendant is cautioned and discharged with a stern warning to stay of trouble.

His account in Access Bank is to be closed permanently though from the statement attached the highest amount lodged there was just N14,000. (Fourteen Thousand Naira) only.

He will enter a written undertaking to desist from such fraudulent acts with his passport photograph attached.
