JUDGMENT

The charge against the defendant is dated 30th day of May, 2023 and filed on same day which reads as follows:

1. That you, **Akintewe Wisdom Pamilerin**, sometime in 2022 in Ilorin within the jurisdiction of this Honourable Court, did cheat by personation when you pretended to be a white female named Roselyn Maacarthly with email address roselynmccarthy582@gmail.com and convinced one Ken Emineth to send you the sum of \$3,100 from his Chase Bank Account under the guise of being his female lover, an offence contrary to Section 321 of the Penal Code Law and punishable under Section 322 of the Penal Code Law.

The defendant pleaded guilty to the charge.

The Prosecution thereafter reviewed the facts of the case and tendered the following items in evidence:

1. Two EFCC computer/telephone ownership attestation forms in the name of Akintewe Wisdom Pamilerin - Exhibits 1A and 1B.
2. One phone identified as iphone 14 - Exhibit 2.
3. One phone identified as Samsung phone - Exhibit 3.
4. A bunch of computer generated internet documents together with a certificate of identification - Exhibits 4A and 4B.
5. Two statements of Akintewe Wisdom dated 2/5/23 and 9/5/23 - Exhibits 5A and 5B.

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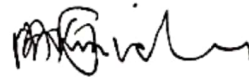
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6. The sum of \$3100 dollars – Exhibit 6.

Upon the plea of guilty by the defendant to the lone count in issue in this case, the prosecution has proceeded to review the facts of this case through the investigating officer, PW1 also placing in evidence certain Exhibits connected with the case.

The defendant having also confirmed to the Court that his plea of guilt relates to the facts as reviewed, the Court is satisfied about his guilt in respect of the offence in issue.

Consequently, the provision of section 280 Kwara State Administration of Criminal Justice Law is invoked and he is found guilty and convicted as charged.

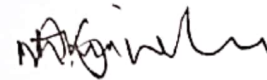


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SENTENCE: The convict is sentenced to Six months imprisonment but with the option of payment of a fine of ₦100,000 (One Hundred Thousand Naira).

Exhibit 2 (iphone 14), being the instrument of crime and Exhibit 6 (\$3,100), being the restituted proceed of crime are both ordered to be forfeited to the Federal Government.

Exhibit 3, having not been linked with the crime and upon the application of counsel to the convict, with the prosecution not objecting is ordered to be released to the convict.

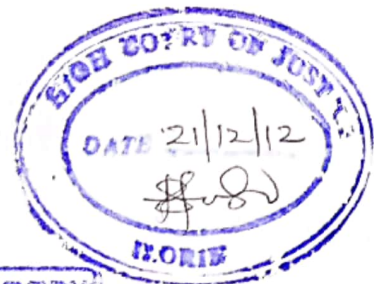
