**JUDGMENT**

The Defendant is charged in one count with possession of fraudulent documents contrary to Section 6 and 8 of the Advance Fee Fraud Act 2006. He pleaded guilty to the charge.

The Court is informed that the Defendant applied for a plea deal. This resulted in a Plea Bargain Agreement being entered into with the commission.


I have listened to the facts of the case as presented by the prosecution. I have also heard the Learned Counsel's plea on his behalf.

In sentencing the Defendant, the Court has taken into consideration the fact that by pleading guilty, the Defendant has saved the time of the Court. I have also examined the Plea Bargain Agreement and I find it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Defendant is sentenced to a term of 3 years or pay a fine of N200,000.00.

He will forfeit Samsung S10+ mobile phone and all his accounts as described in paragraph 4 of the Plea bargain Agreement are to be permanently closed.

The Defendant will enter a written undertaking to be of good conduct going forward, and his passport photograph is to be attached thereto.
