COUNT 1

That you, Lateef Adenaike Olamilekan sometime in August, 2022 at Ningi Local government area of Bauchi, Bauchi State within the Jurisdiction of this Honorable Court knowingly and without lawful authority causes loss of a cumulative sum of N15, 709, 000 (Fifteen Million Seven Hundred and Nine Thousand Naira) property of one Abdu Dangana Ningi by altering and inputting data for the purpose of conferring economic benefit on yourself

**COUNT 3**

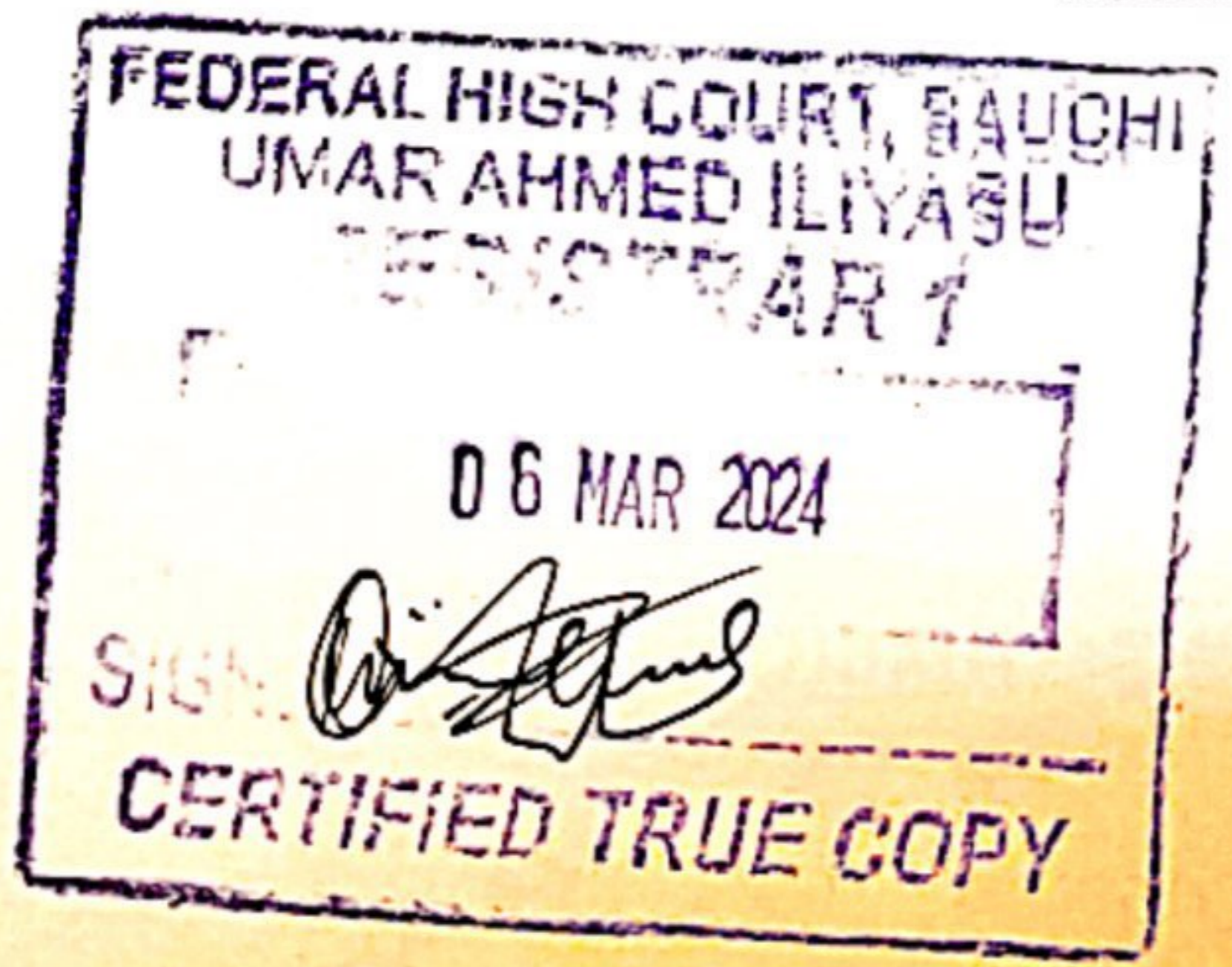
