Defendant having pleaded guilty to the essential elements of the offense stated on the amended charge dated 12th August, 2022 and filed on 3rd November, 2022 is found guilty as charged. The plea bargain agreement also dated 12th August, 2022 filed on 3rd November, 2022 is made the judgment of this court to wit: Convict is sentenced to 5 years in the custody of the Nigeria correctional service commencing from today with option of fine of 300,000. Orders of forfeiture and none foreclosure are made as stated at paragraph 3, 4 and 5 of the plea bargain agreement
