Charge read and explained to the Defendant in English Language and he understands the Charge and pleads guilty to the One Count Charge.

Prosecution: Facts as per charge. Tenders 3 Computer Ownership Forms, certificate of identification, 3 statements of Defendant dated 23/2/2024 and 1/3/2024 respectively, Samsung S8 recovered from the Defendant, iPhone 13 recovered from the Defendant,



one Laptop Apple MacBook Air, one Toyota Camry car, key to the car as exhibits.

Defence Counsel: No objection.

Court: The documents and items listed above are admitted as *Exhibits A, B, C, D, E1-3, F, G, H, J and K* respectively.

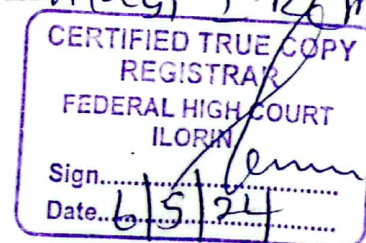
Prosecution: Case for the prosecution.

Court: On the plea of Defendant and the facts before me, I find the Defendant guilty as charged.

Convict: ~~Pleas~~ Pleads for leniency. Promises not to do it again.

Defence Counsel: ~~Prays~~ Prays for leniency. Prays the Court to consider the plea of guilty and the remorsefulness of Defendant. He is a 400 Level student of Kwara State University.

Prosecution: No record of previous conviction. Leaves sentence to the discretion of this Court. Prays for the forfeiture of the *Exhibits F, G, H, J, and K*.



SENTENCE

The Convict is a first time offender and has pleaded guilty without trial which is a sign of genuine repentance. He is also a student of Kwara State University at 400 level and if given opportunity he can turn a better person for himself, family and society.

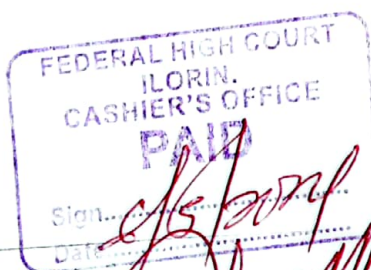
He shall pay a fine of Two Hundred Thousand Naira (₦200,000.00). He shall also be bond to be of good behavior for 6 months and shall enter into such bond with one surety whose address shall be verified by the Station Registrar of this Court. Both surety and Defendant shall deposit 3 passport photographs each and shall report to the Station Registrar of this Court every 1st Monday of the month starting from April, 2024. If within the 6 months period, the Convict commits the same or similar offence, he shall be brought to this Court to face the full punishment under the Section otherwise he shall be discharged.



The *Exhibits F, G, H, J and K* are hereby forfeited to the Federal Government of Nigeria. The *Exhibits 'F' and 'G'* shall be destroyed by the EFCC in the presence of the Police and Court officials.

Exhibits H, J and K shall be disposed of by the Commission in line with Section 31(2) of the EFCC Act, 2004 by an advertised public auction in the presence of the Station Registrar of this Court. The Order of disposal of *Exhibits H, J and K* are not to be carried out until after 90 days if there is no appeal. The proceeds shall be paid into the Consolidated Revenue of the Federal Government of Nigeria.
