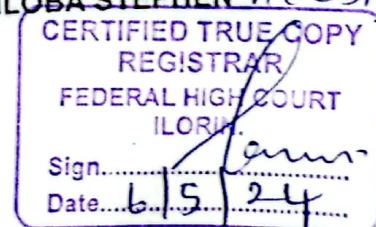
Interpreter: Read the charge to the Defendant

Balogun: We have no objection my lord.

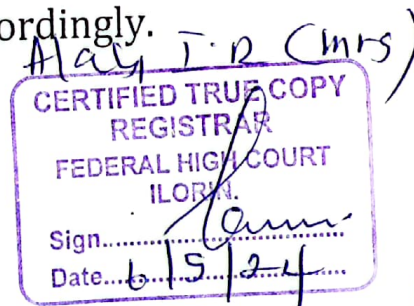
