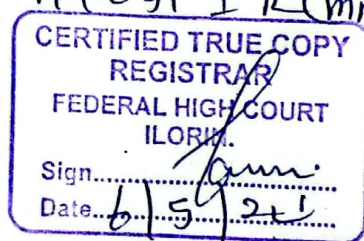

Charge is read and explained to the Defendant in English Language he understands the charge and pleads guilty to counts 1 and 2 respectively.

Prosecution: Facts as per charge. Tenders the ownership attestation forms, certificate of identification,

Statements of Defendant dated 22/3/24, 27/2/24,

Alabi I. R. (mrs) and 11/3/24 respectively, Iphone 113 promax and



Samsung galaxyS9 both recovered from Defendant,
\$350 USD restituted by Defendant in the following
denominations:

\$100 - 3 pieces

\$50 - 1 piece as exhibits

Court: The above listed documents in order listed admitted
as *exhibits A,B,C,D1-3,E, and G1-4 respectively.*

Prosecution: Case for the prosecution.

Court: On the plea of Defendant and the facts before me, I
finde the Defendant guilty as charged in counts 1
and 3 respectively.

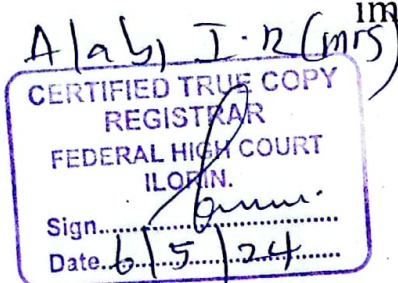
Convict: Pleads for leniency. Says he has learnt his lessons
and is now a changed person.



Def. Counsel: Pleads for leniency. He is a first time offender, a 20 years old graduate. He confessed of the earliest opportunity and has restituted the sum of N350.

Prosecution: My Lord, we have no record of previous conviction. We leave sentence to the discretion of this Court. Prays for forfeiture of exhibits *E,F,G1-4* *respectively*. The convict is a first time offender and has pleaded guilty without trial which is a sign of genuine repentance. He is however a graduate of Kwara State College of Education and should have found a genuine means of livelihood using the money he used to purchase the *exhibits E, and F* *respectively*.

I also take into consideration the fact that he has fully restituted the amount he earned from the commission of offence. I sentence him to 8 months imprisonment in count 1 with an option of fine of



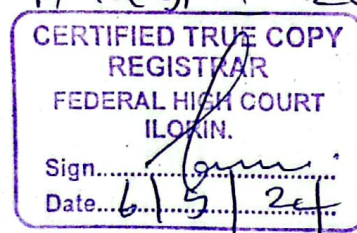
N200,000.00. I sentence him to 8 months imprisonment I count 2 with an option of fine of N200,000.00.

Both sentences shall run concurrently and with a cumulative fine option of N400,000.00.

The exhibits E,F,G1-4 respectively are forfeited to the Federal Government of Nigeria.

The *exhibits E and F respectively* shall be destroyed by the EFCC in the presence of Court officials.

The exhibits G1-4 shall be lodged into the consolidated revenue fund of the Federal Government of Nigeria by the Station Registrar of this Court forthwith.



The order of destruction of *exhibit E and F* shall not be carried out until after the fine for appeal has lapsed.
